

Building work

Ground works for our two new classrooms are due to start this week. Unfortunately works have been delayed which means the 2 new classrooms are not expected to be ready until mid-October. These new classrooms will be for year 6 to use once completed. In the meantime, Lime class will remain in their current classroom, whilst Rowan with be based in Cedar for the beginning of the Autumn term. This will allow works to be undertaken on the upstairs corridor over the summer. We are developing more space for children to be supported working in the Thrive room and space for staff to work, social workers and agencies to work with children 1:1 and for us to be able to reinstate the school library. We don't envisage the works interrupting the children's learning, however there will be some disruption to parking outside of school during this week and the first half term.

SATs Results

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Dinner Money/Parent Pay

Could we ask parents to clear all dinner money balances on Parent Pay and ensure accounts are kept in credit AT ALL TIMES. Dinner money should be paid via Parent Pay in advance of your child taking a school meal. Parents can set an alert when balances are running low to ensure accounts do not fall into deficit.

From September 2023 we have been advised by the Local Authority that the price of a school meal will increase from £2.30 to £3.25 per meal. This is a huge increase and is the result of the increases in food prices, wages and transportation costs. We would encourage all parents to complete the online Free School Meals application as the service automatically checks eligibility and will highlight families who become eligible, and this eligibility remains for their current phase of education (i.e. until reaching secondary school).
