<u>Food Support Voucher – available from January 2023</u>

Eligible households will automatically receive a one-off food voucher worth around £40 per eligible child / young person.

The vouchers will be available for:

- children who receive benefit related free school meals
- children in an early years setting (nurseries and pre-schools) who receive <u>free childcare for 2 year-olds</u> or the <u>early years pupil premium for 3 and 4-year-olds</u>
- care leavers aged up to 21 years of age living independently

No application is needed - vouchers will be sent by email or text message.
