

Some staff in school you might meet








Turn to face the playground and walk down until you see the big gap in the wall.








Can you see the mirror on the wall? That is so you can see around the corner to where your classroom is.




There is a big clearing under the trees that we use for forest schools, it feels like you are in the woods.
