Food provided in school

Some children may on occasion arrive at school without having any breakfast due to an unsettled start to the day or if families have been in a rush. On these occasions or if a child is struggling and saying they are hungry we may offer them a slice of toast. We would like to reassure parents that we would only provide children with toast on white bread with butter and staff will ensure that we follow any existing allergy/intolerance information provided from home. If you need to update school with any allergy/intolerance information, please contact the school office.

Food Provided from home

We are happy for children to bring in healthy snacks for breaktime and promote a healthy balanced packed lunch being provided by home. We can also provide a mixture of school dinners and children bringing in packed lunches from home if children want to only stay certain days. Parents may wish to send in food flasks as the weather gets cooler, please ensure food is an appropriate temperature so as not to burn. Please bear in mind we continue to operate a nut free policy in school if providing food from home.

Forest Schools

The leaves are really beginning to fall, down at the Forest School site this week. By the time we return after half term there will be much less shelter from the wind and rain left for us. With this in mind please ensure that your child comes to school prepared for the weather on their Forest School Day with old clothes with long sleeves and long legs, a coat, a change of shoes, wellies or boots that are ok to get wet and muddy, socks and a hat and gloves for when it gets really cold.
