School Dinners

School dinners are being increased to £2.30 per day. We ask that you please ensure you have enough funds on ParentPay for the week if your child is staying dinners. Your child can select which days to stay dinners for at Hallam Fields so they do not need to stay for the full week if they don't like the menu on certain days.

Inset days and First Day Back

In September staff will start back on Thursday 1st September for two Inset days, with **children starting back on Monday 5th September**. Start and finish times from September will be;

Year 4 and Year 6 - 8.55am to 3.25pm and Year 3 and Year 5 - 9.00am to 3.30pm.

Year 3 and 4 will continue to use the car park gate and years 5 and 6 the main gate by reception.

We will send out details at the beginning of term when your child's PE and Forest School days are. All children should come to school in school uniform on Monday 5th September.

<u>PE Kit</u>

We have had a few queries about PE Kit for September. To clarify, all children will need a white t-shirt for PE. This can be with or without a school logo. They should have PLAIN black PE shorts or tracksuit bottoms. Some parents have queried whether girls can wear plain black skorts as opposed to shorts, which we have also agreed to. Trainers for PE should be PLAIN black. We have been asked about trainers that are black and have plain black logos on, these are also fine as completely black. Children should also wear their normal school jumper or fleece with their PE Kit and we will be enforcing this from September. Thank you in supporting us in the move to a new PE kit.
