Welcome

Welcome to all of our new children in year 3 and those who have joined other year groups. We have also welcomed some new members of staff this year. Miss Ramsell-Smith has joined us as a class teacher in year 3 and Mrs Hewitt and Mrs Stevenson have joined us as teaching assistants working mainly in year 3.

Come to lunch

For those of you who have not been before to a 'come to lunch' each year group/class has a date set where you as parents (or Grandparents) are invited into school to spend some time in your child's class from 11.30am(often completing a task!) before having a school lunch with your child. There is then a chance to have a hot drink with staff before the children go back into lessons. Congratulations

At the end of the summer term we were delighted to be awarded the Silver ArtsMark Award. Mrs Smedley who coordinates art has overseen the work and development of the arts across the school. We see this as really important for the children to have lots of experiences / opportunities and not just focus on Literacy and Numeracy. We managed to take children to art galleries, the theatre and had different artists in school to work with the children (and for staff training) over the past couple of years.

In sports after another successful year, with some more trophies, we have achieved the Gold Active Mark again for a third year. Miss Godrigde continues to work in school delivering one of the children's PE lessons each week, and we finished the year off in July with a PE awards evening—well done to all the winners.

Christmas Panto

After a successful Panto trip last year we are once again taking the children to see the Panto. We will be using money raised at fundraising events to subsidise the bus, and therefore ask you to pay the remaining balance (which is payable on Parent Pay). The cost of the ticket is £12.50 to see Jack and the Beanstalk. This year we will be going to the panto at Derby Arena. We will be taking years 3 and 4 on Wednesday 12th December and years 5 and 6 on Thursday 13th December. We will take the children during the afternoon although we may be back after 3.30pm depending on the finishing time (details to follow later). The cost for the theatre ticket is £12.50 and will be on Parent Pay for you to pay for from today. We ask for all payments by Friday 16th November to finalise numbers.

Christmas Dinner—ORDER BY 12th October

We shall be having our school Christmas Dinner during the week beginning 10th December. We ask that any child wanting Christmas dinner stays for the full week so that the kitchen are able to order the right amount of food and have enough staff. Please complete on ParentPay to say your child will be staying—this MUST BE
COMPLETED BY Friday 12th October for the kitchen to be able to order the meals.

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals we will automatically order a dinner for them.

Security at School

We have just finished changing the entrance system to school. This means that if you arrive after 9am the far gate will be closed as well as the main door. There is a bell and intercom on the gate, and once you have been 'buzzed in' the gate and door will open for you. If you are in school during the day the office will now need to release the door and gate for you to be able to leave. The main gate will be opened from 8.40am for the children arriving early to be able to stand by the main door ready to come in from 8.50am. There will be no difference for them of an evening leaving.
