

Beginning and end of the day

We have had a few parents who have commented how busy it is especially at pick up time and how hard it is to see their child. During Covid we had been able to stagger the start and end of the day by longer, whilst fitting around Field House Infant School and also with Derbyshire County Council agreeing to the increase in hours for our crossing patrol. However, this was only on a temporary basis and for many reasons we have had to return to times which are much closer together. We didn't want to return though to all the children coming in and leaving at the same time as had happened over many years.

We appreciate how limited the space is outside of school to wait and have been asking the county council for a number of years to convert the land outside of school by the fence so that there is more space for parents to stand, as well as to possibly put a locked scooter storage on. So far, we have been unsuccessful however we are once again arguing the point on grounds of the safety of all. In order to help the situation can we please ask that at the beginning of the day ONLY year 4 and year 6 children (including any parents) are stood next to school when the gates open and they come in for 8.55am. Once these years have come in then year 3 and 5 can come to the gates to line up before they come in at 9.00am.

At the end of the day if you are collecting a child from either year 3 or year 5 then we ask that you please step back and allow the children to leave from year 4 and year 6 first at 3.25pm, this will make it easier for staff to see the adults collecting the children quicker and then they can have left when year 3 and 5 come out for 3.30pm.
